OUTLOOK

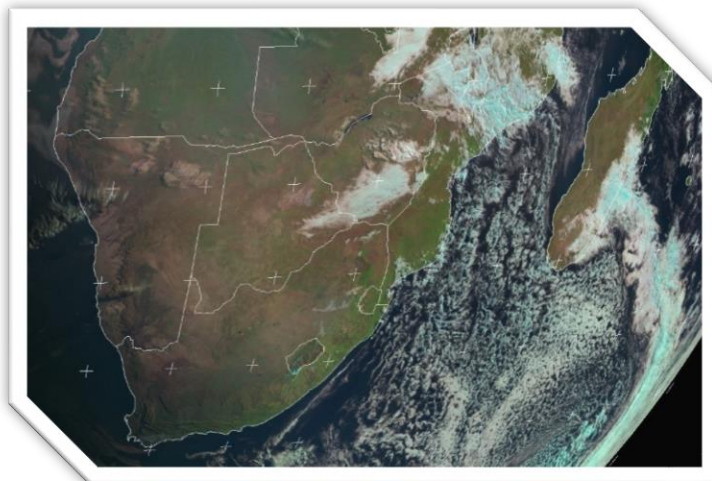
Slightly warmer in the south, mild in the north.

Perfect time to be cozy around a fire.

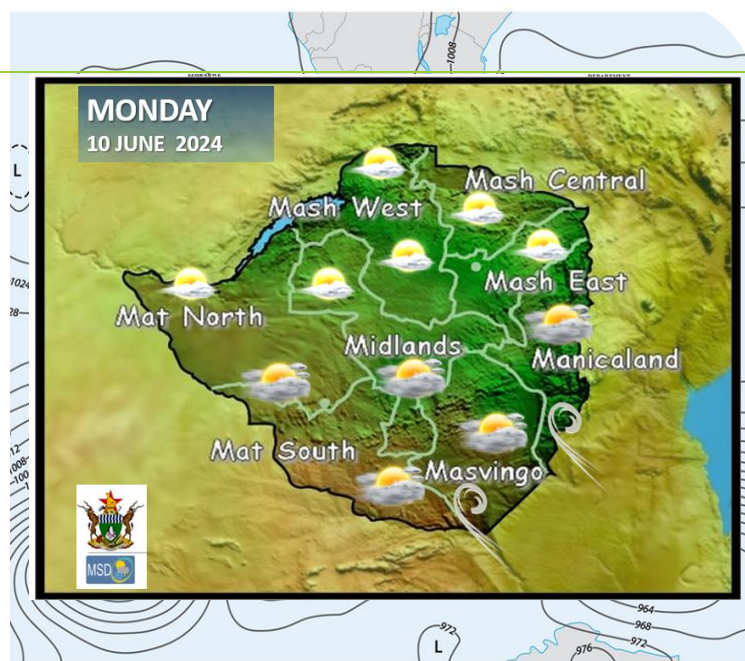
Warmer Wednesday



The prevailing cool moist south easterly airflow that is still over the country brought cloudy, windy and cool conditions in the southern and eastern parts of the country. Light drizzle was reported in **Gwanda, Zvishavane, Masvingo, Makoholi, Zaka, Chisengu and Chipinge**. The rest of the country experienced cool conditions and brief clouds in the morning and became mostly sunny by the afternoon. Areas along the high veld had mild conditions, areas in the eastern highlands had cold conditions and areas to the northwest had warm conditions.



WEATHER FOR TOMORROW MONDAY 10 JUNE 2024



Expect cloudy, windy and cool conditions throughout the day in **Matabeleland south, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, the southern parts of Masvingo and the Midlands province** with a chance of light drizzle in places. All **Mashonaland provinces, Harare Metropolitan provinces and the northern parts of Manicaland** should be partly cloudy, windy and cold in the morning. However, by the afternoon these areas should be briefly cloudy and warm with a cool breeze from time to time.

IMPACTS

- Chances of catching a **cough, influenza or a cold**, increase during this transition period towards winter. Please consult your local health practitioner for any health-related ailments.
- If there is need to use a brazier (mbaura/imbaula) or fire to keep warm, **please ensure the room is well ventilated**.
- **Winter cropping plans and activities** should be done in consultation with local Agritex Officers

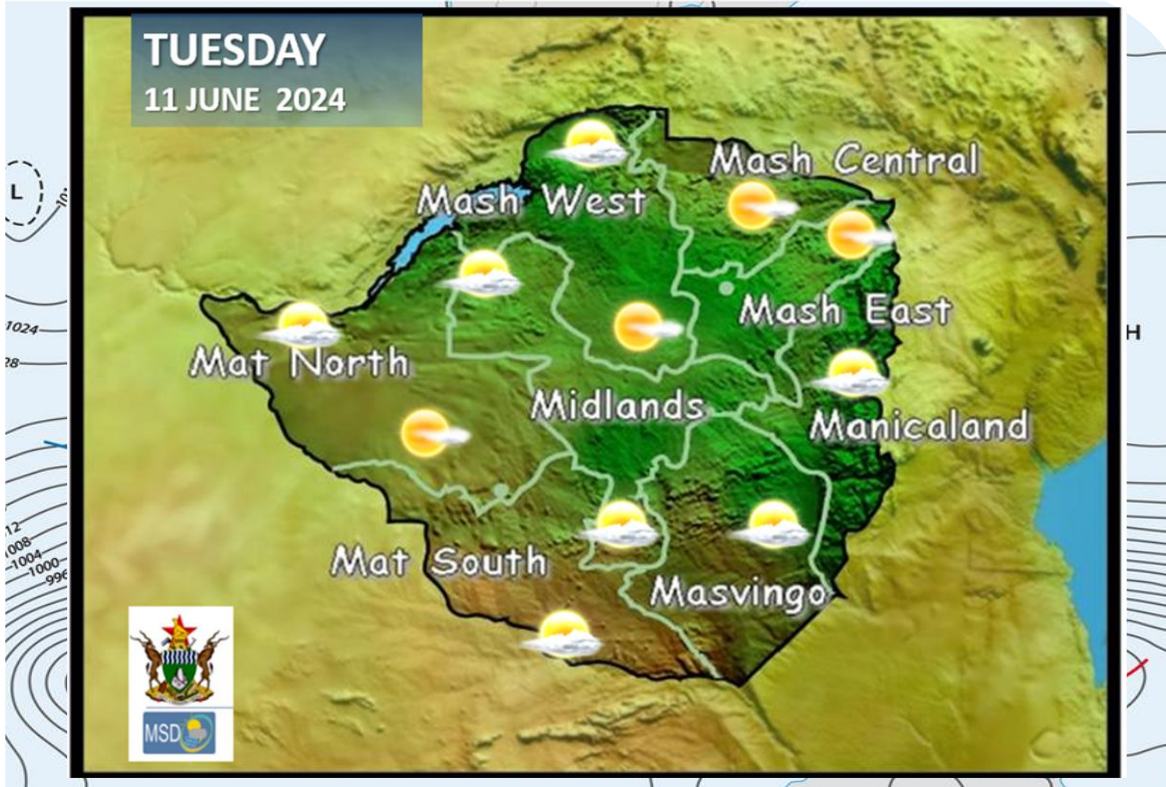

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR TUESDAY 11 JUNE 2024

Anticipate brief clouds, windy and cool conditions in the southern and eastern parts of the country that is in; **Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo and Manicaland provinces** in the morning and by the afternoon temperatures are expected to be in the mild category. The rest of the country should be mostly sunny and cold during the start of the day and by the afternoon warm conditions should prevail. Areas along the **Zambezi** and **Limpopo valleys**, are anticipated to be briefly cloudy and mild in the morning becoming warm by the afternoon under mostly sunny conditions. Temperatures are expected to start increasing on this day.
