



WEATHER REPORT & Forecast



Much of the country yesterday, experienced sunny and hot conditions, with very high temperatures reported in areas along the Zambezi and Save Valley during the afternoon. The highest temperatures recorded were in **Beitbridge (44°C), Chiredzi (43°C), Kanyemba (41°C), Binga (40°C), Gwanda (40°C), and Lupane (40°C)**. Today, brief clouds appeared over Matabeleland South provinces. It started off mild across all areas but became sunny and very hot by midday. By the evening, clear skies and warm conditions were prevalent.

Morning.: Anticipate clear skies and mild conditions over much of the country with brief clouds in all **Matabeleland provinces**.

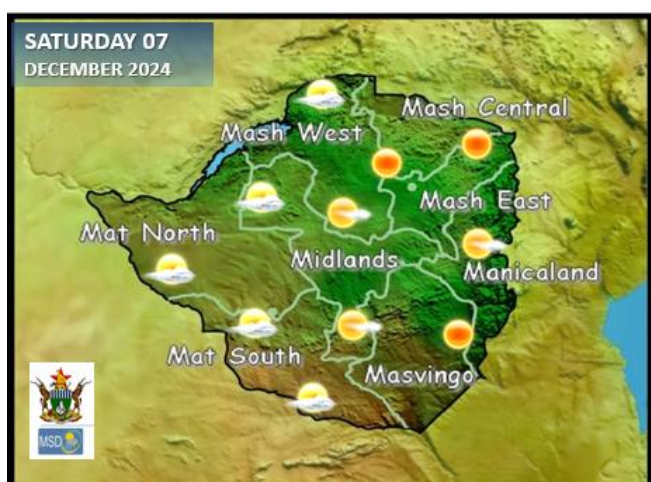

Overnight: Clear skies and warm conditions.

Morning: Clear skies in all areas except for the western parts of the country which should be briefly cloudy.

Afternoon: In **Mashonaland West, Bulawayo Metropolitan and all Matabeleland provinces**, it should be partly cloudy with a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery in places. The rest of the country should be sunny and hot.

Overnight: Clear skies and mild conditions.

Impacts & Actions to Take:

- Irrigate/water crops when heat stress is noted.
- When thunder roars , stay indoors.
