SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SATURDAY 11 JANUARY 2025

WEATHER REPORT & Forecast



Widespread thunderstorms were experienced countrywide due to the abundance of moisture and atmospheric instability. Heavy rainfall was mainly in Mashonaland West, Masvingo and some parts of Matabeleland South provinces. The highest rainfall amounts were recorded in Masvingo(55mm), Gwanda(39mm), Guruve(33mm), Mvurwi(31mm), Kwekwe (15mm) and Kariba(13mm). Other areas had rainfall below 10mm. This morning, cloudy and mild conditions with moderate showers were experienced over the southern, western and northern parts of the country. The eastern parts of the country were briefly cloudy in the morning. However, by the afternoon it became partly cloudy and warm in all areas with isolated thunder showers in places. The atmosphere over the country continues to be abundant in moisture and there is a slight pressure rise in the south east coast of South Africa.

Meanwhile, the Meteorological Services Department is monitoring **Tropical Cyclone Dikeledi** which is currently located less than 200 km off the coast of Antsiranana province, Madagascar and is moving west-northwest at about 30 km/h.

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: SUNDAY 12 JANUARY 2025



Morning: Cloudy and mild conditions over much of the country with isolated rain showers in places.

Afternoon: Expect partly cloudy and warm conditions with scattered thunderstorms over much of the country. Matabeleland South, Masvingo, the Midlands and the southern parts of Manicaland provinces have a high chance of heavy rainfall.

Overnight: Cloudy and mild conditions over the southern and eastern parts of the country, with a chance of isolated showers. The remaining areas should be partly cloudy.











