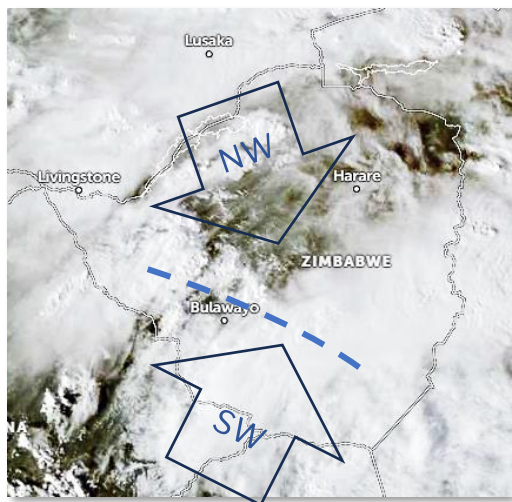


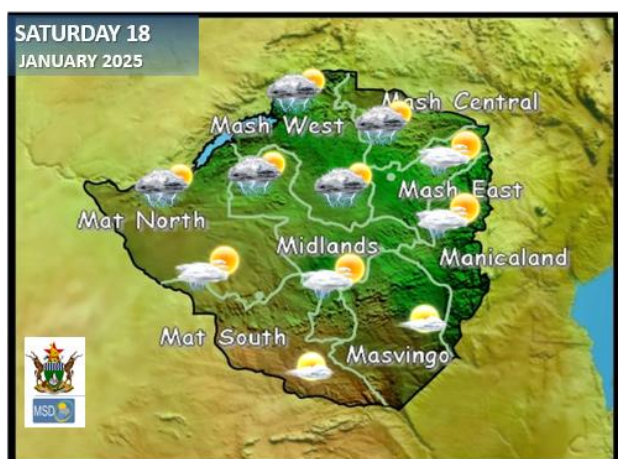
Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, FRIDAY 17 JANUARY 2025



There were heavy rains, yesterday, in areas near **Hwange (31mm)**, **Nkayi (65mm)**, **Gweru (43mm)**, **Makoholi (96mm)** and **Zaka (51mm)** [along the confluence line in blue on the map]. This occurred due to a northwesterly (NW) airflow converging with a relatively cooler southwesterly (SW) wind. This south-westerly wind also drove moisture into Matabeleland South, where **West Nicholson (39mm)**, **Kezi (36mm)** and **Matopos (33mm)** had considerable falls. While to the north, the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) resulted in downpours over **Centenary (55mm)**, **Bindura (45mm)**, **Rushinga (37mm)**, **Dotito-Karoi (35mm)**, and **Mount Darwin (34mm)**. By this morning the NW and SW winds had shifted into a north-easterly and southerly direction, with the latter slowly drying out the atmosphere from South Africa into the country.

WEATHER FOR TOMORROW: SATURDAY 18 JANUARY 2025



Morning: Anticipate mostly cloudy and mild conditions in all areas with a chance of light showers in places.

Afternoon: **Mashonaland provinces, the Midlands, Matabeleland North and the northern parts of Manicaland provinces:** Expect cloudy and warm conditions with a chance of scattered thunderstorms.

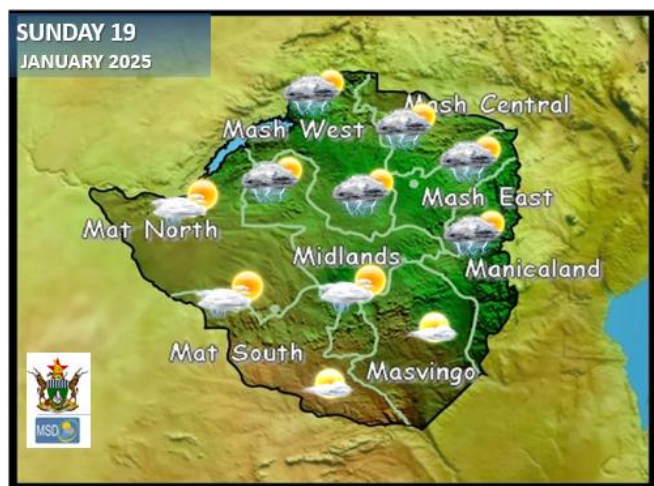
All other areas to the south should be mostly cloudy and warm with isolated thundershowers.

Overnight: Partly cloudy and mild conditions in all areas.

Impacts & Actions to Take:

- When thunder roars it is best to be indoors.

Morning: Cloudy north; partly cloudy south, with mild conditions countrywide.

Afternoon: The country's southern half should be partly cloudy and hot; while **all Mashonaland provinces, the Midlands, Matabeleland North, and the northern parts of Manicaland provinces** should anticipate cloudy and warm conditions with scattered thunderstorms.

Overnight: Partly cloudy and mild conditions over much of the country.
