SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, FRIDAY 14 MARCH 2025

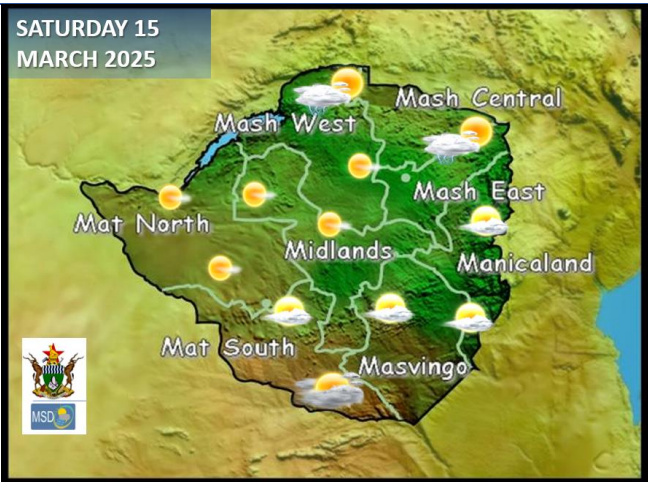


Isolated thundershowers occurred in the extreme northern parts of Mashonaland West and Mashonaland Central provinces, yesterday. This was due to moisture from the fringes of the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ). The highest rainfall amounts were only **11 mm (Mvurwi), 10 mm (Karozi), and 7 mm (Guruve).**

Meanwhile, this morning, an influx of cool and moist south-easterly winds over southern Manicaland, Matabeleland South, and Masvingo Provinces resulted in brief cloudy periods as well as light rain and drizzle.

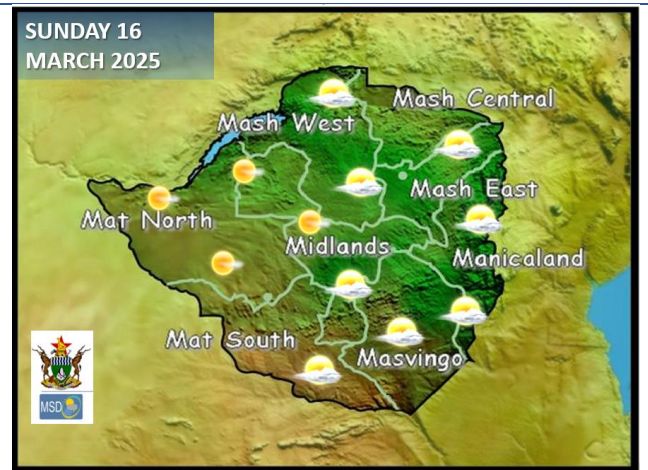
All other parts of the country had mostly clear skies and mild conditions, but became warm by afternoon, with winds strengthening towards evening.

Matabeleland South, Masvingo, southern Midlands and Manicaland Provinces	Mostly cloudy, windy and mild with light rain and drizzle, becoming less cloudy towards evening
All Mashonaland, northern parts of Manicaland.	Mostly sunny, humid and warm, with brief cloudy periods and isolated thunder showers.
Actions to Take:	Plan with the weather in mind and move to safe shelter during thunderstorms
Matabeleland North, northern Midlands. Harare and Bulawayo Metropolitan Provinces.	Mostly sunny and warm by afternoon with a light breeze time and again, but mild both morning and evening
Actions to Take:	Wear a sunhat if there is need to be outdoors for an extended period.

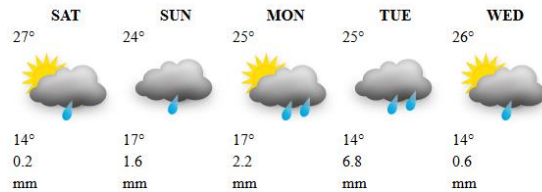

Actions to Take:	Move to safe shelter during thunder and lightning
Manicaland, the Midlands, Matabeleland South and Masvingo provinces.	Mostly cloudy and mild at first, becoming partly cloudy and warm by noon.
Matabeleland North, northern Midlands, and Bulawayo Metropolitan provinces	Mostly clear skies; mild conditions in the morning becoming and warm in the afternoon.
Actions to Take:	Stay hydrated during the day and dress warmly towards the evening.



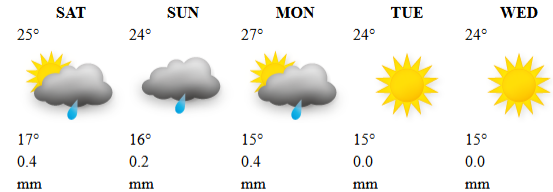
