



## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, FRIDAY 14 MARCH 2025



Isolated thundershowers occurred in the extreme northern parts of Mashonaland West and Mashonaland Central provinces, yesterday. This was due to moisture from the fringes of the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ). The highest rainfall amounts were only 11 mm (Mvurwi), 10 mm (Karoi), and 7 mm (Guruve).

Meanwhile, this morning, an influx of cool and moist south-easterly winds over southern Manicaland, Matabeleland South, and Masvingo Provinces resulted in brief cloudy periods as well as light rain and drizzle.

All other parts of the country had mostly clear skies and mild conditions, but became warm by afternoon, with winds strengthening towards evening.


