



SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING. THURSDAY 13 MARCH 2025



There were showers to the north of the country, with rain and drizzle to the south, yesterday. The heaviest falls were mostly to the southeast, with 31mm at Mutare, 29mm at Chisengu, 24mm at Chipinge, 22mm at Chisumbanje, and 21mm at Chivi. This was due to moisture from the Moderate Tropical Storm Jude, which has turned back to the Mozambican Channel, and is slowly moving towards the southern region of Madagascar at 18km/hr.

Today: Partly cloudy and mild conditions were prevalent across the country, with brief cloudy periods over the southern and eastern parts of the country, coupled with isolated showers and light rain. Meanwhile, winds a slowly strengthening over the south coast of Southern Africa.
