


SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, MONDAY 31 MARCH 2025



Moisture drifting into Mashonaland Central and Harare Metropolitan Province from Zambia, combined with an influx of moist south-easterly winds over Manicaland Province, resulted in scattered thunderstorms and localized heavy rainfall in some areas. Notable rainfall amounts were recorded in Chisengu (30 mm), Harare Belvedere (14 mm), Mukandi (16 mm), Rusape (14 mm), and Nyanga (8 mm). The rest of the country remained partly cloudy and warm, with light showers in Matabeleland North and Bulawayo Metropolitan Provinces.

This morning, remnant moisture over the northern and eastern parts of the country led to briefly cloudy and mild conditions. As the day progressed, much of the country experienced partly cloudy and warm conditions.

Plan with the weather in mind.


Mashonaland West and Matabeleland North provinces.
