


# SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, TUESDAY 01 APRIL 2025



Isolated thunderstorms occurred over Matabeleland North, Bulawayo and the northern parts of the Midlands provinces due to atmospheric instability and moisture that drifted into the western parts of the country yesterday. Notable rainfall amounts were measured in Bulawayo Goetz Observatory(18mm), Kwekwe(14mm), Plumtree(14mm) and Nkayi(8mm). The rest of the country experienced partly cloudy and warm conditions

This morning, it was briefly cloudy with mild conditions over the western and southern parts of the country due to the remnant moisture. As for the remainder of the country, clear skies and mild conditions prevailed in the morning. By the afternoon, much of the country transitioned into partly cloudy and warm conditions

and Masvingo Provinces.


Clear skies and mild conditions in the morning. Mostly sunny and warm in the afternoon, becoming mild in the evening.


