


SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, THURSDAY 10 APRIL 2025



The moisture that entered the country from Botswana resulted in scattered thunderstorms over much of the country except for the extreme north-eastern areas. Notable rainfall amounts were recorded in **Victoria Falls(18mm), Bulawayo(18mm), Mukandi(17mm), Zvishavane (16mm), Nyanga and Kwekwe(15mm), Masvingo(13mm) Wedza(11mm) and Kutsaga(8mm).**

This morning, the presence of the cloud band over **Matabeleland North, Matabeleland South, Masvingo, the Midlands** as well as the **southern parts of Manicaland provinces** resulted in mostly cloudy and mild conditions. The rest of the country had clear skies in the morning. By the afternoon, much of the country became partly cloudy and warm with isolated showers towards the evening as the cloud system moved further eastwards into the country.

All Mashonaland, Harare Metropolitan, and the northern parts of Manicaland provinces.

Partly cloudy and mild in the morning becoming warm in the afternoon. Scattered thunderstorms remain probable with localized heavy downpours in places.

Take proper shelter during thunder and lightning and plan with the weather in mind.


All Matabeleland, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, Masvingo and the southern parts Manicaland provinces
