


Weather Report & Forecast


SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, MONDAY 14 APRIL 2025



Yesterday, the residual moisture over all Mashonaland, Harare Metropolitan and the northern parts of Manicaland resulted in partly cloudy and isolated showers in places. The rest of the country had mostly sunny and warm conditions due to the dry atmosphere over these areas.

This morning, brief cloudy and mild conditions prevailed over much of **all Mashonaland provinces, Matabeleland North, Masvingo** as well as **Manicaland provinces**. In the areas stretching from Plumtree to Nyanga (the central watershed), mostly clear skies and cool conditions were experienced. As the day progressed, mostly sunny and warm conditions prevailed except for the extreme northern areas which had partly cloudy conditions.

Take proper shelter during thunder and lightning and plan with the weather in mind.


Bulawayo Metropolitan, and both Matabeleland Provinces

Ensure vulnerable members of society are warm in morning and hydrated during the day.


