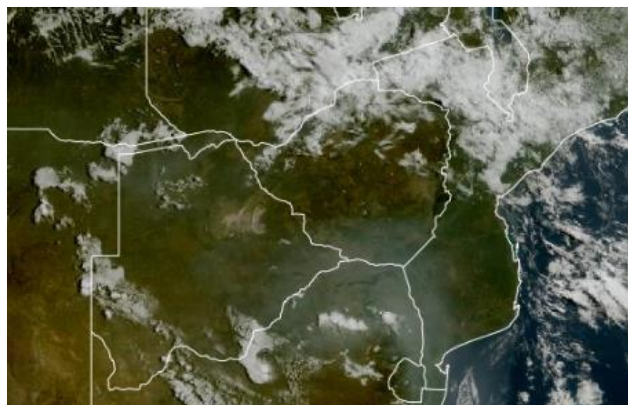




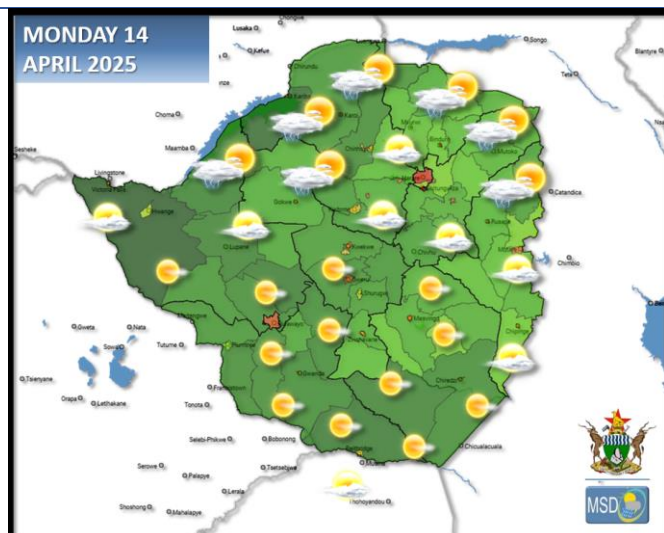
Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, SUNDAY 13 APRIL 2025



The fringes of the Inter-Tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ), which had been drawn slightly southward into the northern districts of the Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, northern Manicaland and much of the Mashonaland Provinces, resulted in light and isolated showers. Yesterday, only a few areas received above 15mm. These include Kariba (19 mm), Gwashure Secondary School in Rushinga (17mm) and Gokwe (16mm). This morning, scattered clouds and mild conditions were over these northern provinces while much of the country had mostly clear skies and cool conditions.

Take proper shelter during thunder and lightning and plan with the weather in mind.

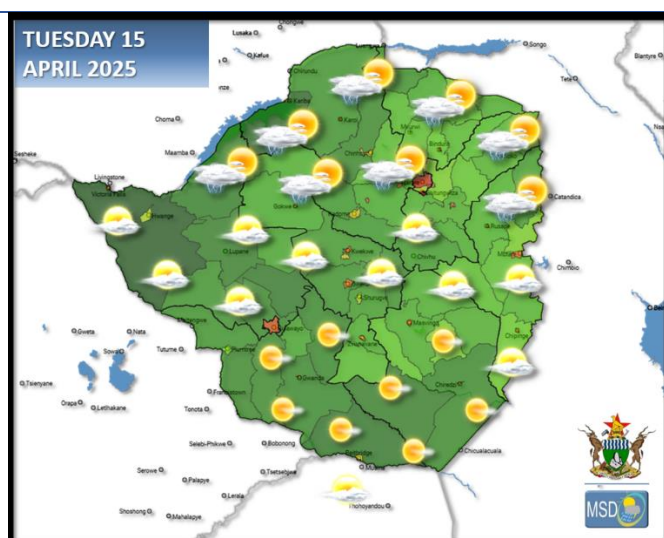
Bulawayo Metropolitan, southern parts of Midlands, Masvingo, southern areas of Manicaland, and both Matabeleland Provinces

Ensure vulnerable members of society are warm in morning and hydrated during the day.

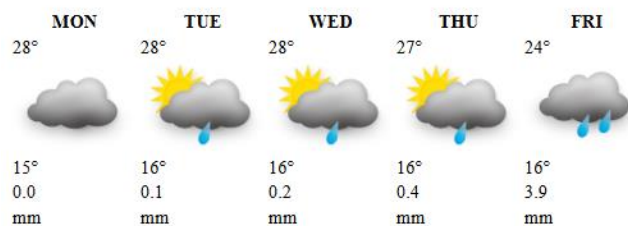
