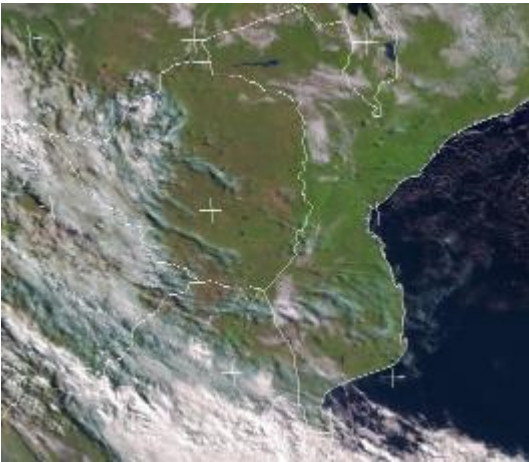


## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, WEDNESDAY 23 APRIL 2025

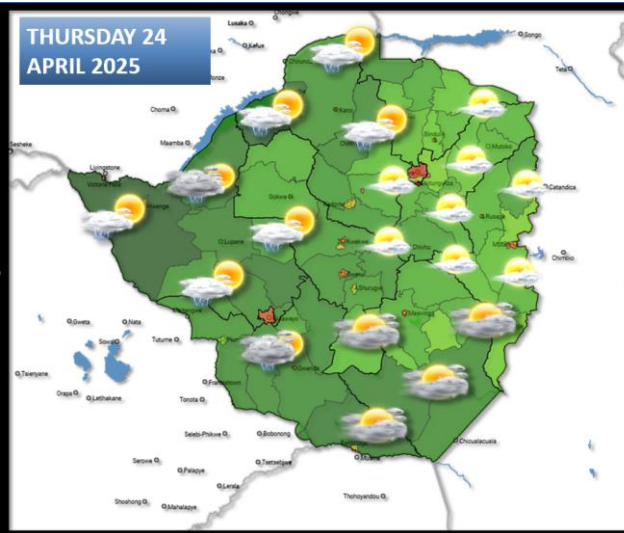


There was no rainfall activity recorded across the entire country. However, a cloud band that moved in from Botswana is currently lying over the southwestern parts of Zimbabwe, bringing partly cloudy and hot conditions.

Today, isolated thundershowers occurred in all of Matabeleland North, Matabeleland South, and Bulawayo Metropolitan provinces. The rest of the country experienced mostly fine and warm weather conditions.

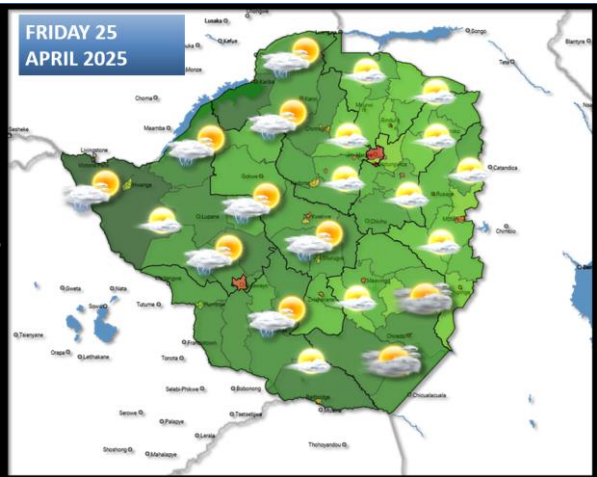
Meanwhile, a high-pressure system over the southeast coast of South Africa is expected to introduce a cool and moist southeasterly airflow into the southeastern parts of Zimbabwe.

## WEATHER FOR TOMORROW: THURSDAY 24 APRIL 2025,



<b>Masvingo, Matabeleland South, South of Manicaland Provinces</b>	Partly cloudy at first becoming warm by afternoon with brief cloudy periods and isolated showers.
<b>North of Manicaland, All Mashonaland and Harare Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, Midlands and Bulawayo Metropolitan Provinces</b>	Partly cloudy and mild in the morning, becoming increasingly cloudy and warm by the afternoon. Scattered thundershowers are expected in Matabeleland North and the Bulawayo Metropolitan Province.
<b>Actions to Take:</b>	<b>Plan outdoor activities with the weather in mind; where possible carry an umbrella.</b>

## WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: FRIDAY 25 APRIL 2025



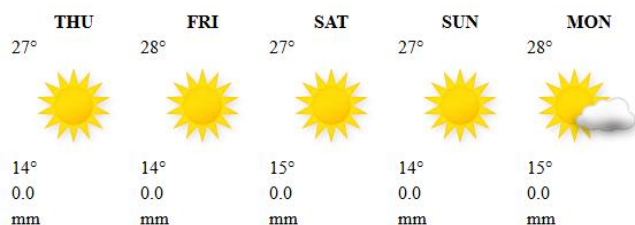

<b>Masvingo, Manicaland, Mashonaland East, Mashonaland Central and Harare Metropolitan Provinces</b>	Mostly partly cloudy and warm for much of the day, with isolated showers expected in the afternoon. It will be cool in the morning and again towards evening.
<b>Actions to Take:</b>	<b>Plan outdoor activities with the weather in mind</b>



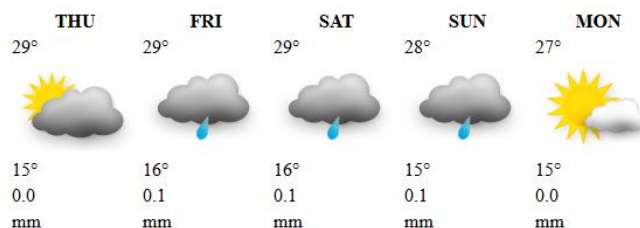
