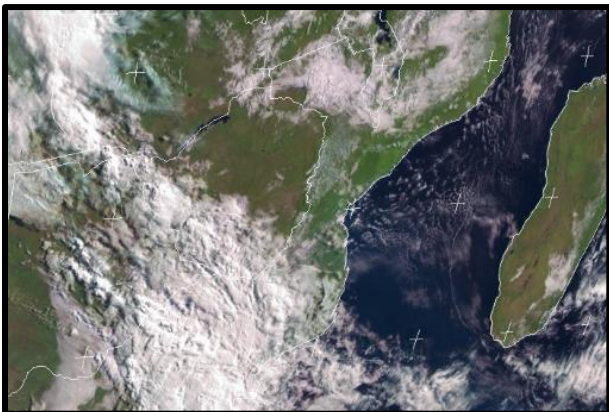


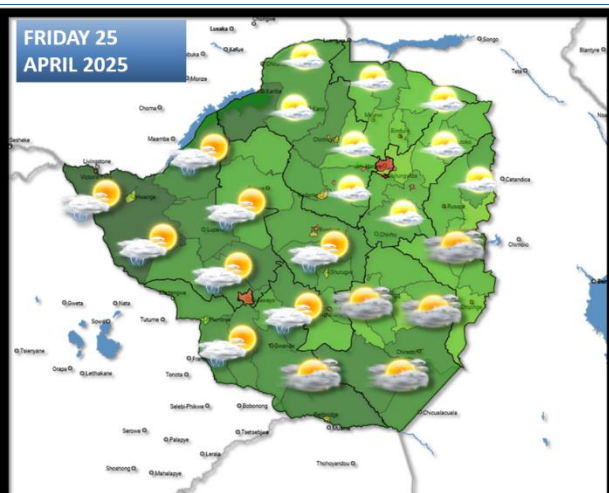
# Weather Report & Forecast

## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, THURSDAY 24 APRIL 2025



A cloud system over Masvingo, Bulawayo Metropolitan, and Matabeleland provinces triggered scattered thunderstorms, with notable rainfall in **Gwanda (35mm), Matopos (16mm), Victoria Falls (12mm), Bulawayo Goetz (8mm), Plumtree (7mm), and Bulawayo Airport (2mm)**, while the rest of the country remained sunny and warm. This morning, cloudy, windy, and mild conditions affected western and southern parts of the country, with clear skies and cooler conditions in the remaining areas. By afternoon, the western and southern areas remained mostly cloudy and warm with isolated showers, as the rest of the country became partly cloudy and warm.

**Plan outdoor activities with the weather in mind; where possible carry an umbrella.**

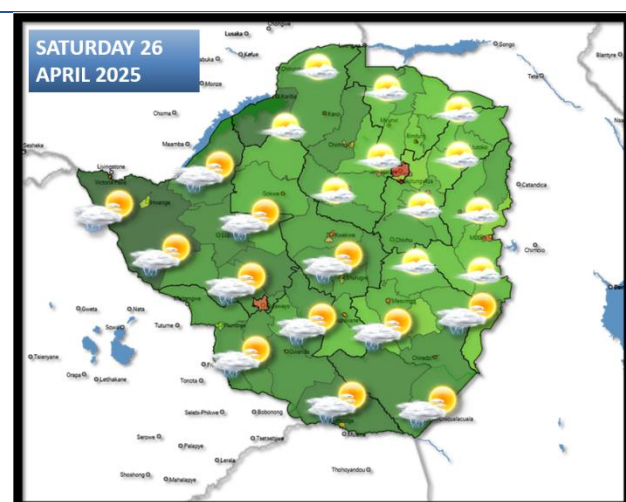
**All Mashonaland, Harare Metropolitan, the Midlands and the northern parts of Manicaland provinces.**
