

## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, MONDAY 28 APRIL 2025

Last night, Harare Metropolitan and Mashonaland East experienced sharp downpours. Some of the highest rainfall measurements included:

- **R. G. Mugabe International Airport:** 47mm
- **Marondera:** 34mm
- **Harare Royal Golf Club:** 22mm
- **Marirangwe Secondary School (Seke):** 17mm


These downpours were driven by the convergence of strengthening south-easterly winds against prevailing north-westerly winds.

Today, the intensifying south-easterly airflow brought cloudy, windy, and mild conditions to parts of Matabeleland South, Masvingo, and Manicaland Provinces. Elsewhere, the weather was characterized by scattered clouds and warm temperatures. By evening, the south-easterly winds began to weaken.



**Ensure young children, the elderly and those of an ill disposition are kept warm overnight.**


**Matabeleland North, northern Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, the northern parts of Manicaland and All Mashonaland Provinces.**

Actions to Take:


**Carry an umbrella for when it rains, but if thunder roars go indoors.**

Actions to Take:


**Ensure young children, the elderly and those of an ill disposition are kept warm, ESPECIALLY EARLY MORNING**




