





SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, SUNDAY 04 MAY 2025



There were two distinct cloud masses over the country; one from the north into the northern parts of Matabeleland North, and all Mashonaland Provinces which resulted in isolated thundershowers; and another from the south-east which led to cloudy, cool and drizzly conditions over Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, much of Midlands, Masvingo and southern parts of Harare Metropolitan, Masholand East and Manicaland Provinces. By evening both cloud masses were fading away.

Actions to Take:

Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, southern parts of Masvingo, Harare Metropolitan and much of Midlands and Mashonaland Provinces.

Cloudy and cool at first becoming partly cloudy and mild by noon and cool towards evening with mostly clear skies.

Ensure young children, the elderly and those of an ill disposition are kept warm, ESPECIALLY EARLY MORNING.


Mostly sunny and warm by day but cool overnight. Brief cloudy periods and an odd shower are probable in the Mashonaland Provinces due to remnant moisture.
