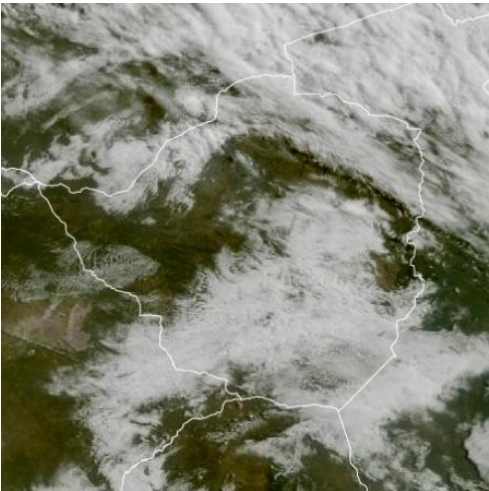

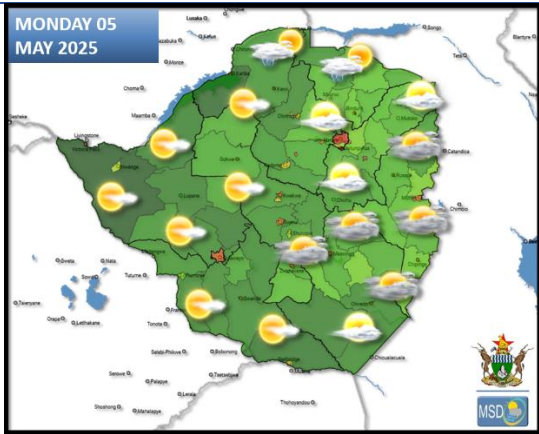
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, SUNDAY 04 MAY 2025



There were two distinct cloud masses over the country; one from the north into the northern parts of Matabeleland North, and all Mashonaland Provinces which resulted in isolated thundershowers; and another from the south-east which led to cloudy, cool and drizzly conditions over Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, much of Midlands, Masvingo and southern parts of Harare Metropolitan, Mashonaland East and Manicaland Provinces. By evening both cloud masses were fading away.

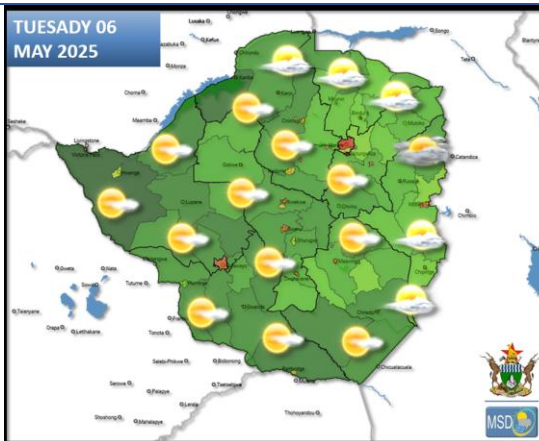
WINTER IS COMING

WEATHER FOR TOMORROW: MONDAY 05 MAY 2025,



Manicaland, northern parts of Masvingo, western parts of Midlands and southern areas of Mashonaland East <u>Actions to Take:</u>	Cloudy and cool at first becoming partly cloudy and mild by noon and cool towards evening with mostly clear skies. Ensure young children, the elderly and those of an ill disposition are kept warm, ESPECIALLY EARLY MORNING.
Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, southern parts of Masvingo, Harare Metropolitan and much of Midlands and Mashonaland Provinces. <u>Actions to Take:</u>	Mostly sunny and warm by day but cool overnight. Brief cloudy periods and an odd shower are probable in the Mashonaland Provinces due to remnant moisture. Prepare for winter

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: TUESDAY 06 MAY 2025



Manicaland Province <u>Actions to Take:</u>	Briefly cloudy and cool in the morning becoming warm by afternoon and cool towards evening. Keep warm overnight.
Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, Midlands, Masvingo, Harare Metropolitan and all Mashonaland Provinces. <u>Actions to Take:</u>	Cool with mostly clear skies and first. Warm by noon becoming mild towards evening. Prepare for winter
