




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING,


SATURDAY 03 MAY 2025



Scattered thunder showers were experienced over much of the country as a result of the moisture that drifted into the country due to the slight pressure rise over the southeast coast of South Africa. Some of the rainfall amounts were recorded in Nkayi(27mm), Nyanga(17mm), Chibero(16mm), Chisumbanje (8mm), and Victoria Falls(7mm), with the remaining areas experiencing rainfall amounts below 5mm. Light rain and drizzle occurred over much of Matabeleland South and Masvingo.

As the pressure weakened overnight, this morning was cloudy and mild across much of the southern, eastern, and northern areas. The western parts of the country had clear skies in the morning. By the afternoon, most areas became partly cloudy and warm, with a gentle breeze at times.

All Mashonaland, Harare Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, the northern parts of Manicaland and Midlands provinces. Briefly cloudy in the morning, becoming warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery in places. Mild both in the morning and evening.

Actions to Take:


Seek shelter during thunder and lightning.

Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, the southern parts of Midlands and Manicaland provinces. Clear skies and mild conditions in the morning transitioning into partly cloudy and warm conditions by the afternoon. Mild during the evening.

Actions to Take:

Ensure young children, the elderly and those of an ill disposition are kept warm, ESPECIALLY EARLY MORNING

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR: MONDAY 05 MAY 2025



All Mashonaland, Harare Metropolitan, Matabeleland North, and the northern parts of the Midlands provinces. Partly cloudy and mild in the morning, gradually becoming warm in the afternoon. Isolated thundershowers are probable in the extreme northern areas.

Actions to Take:

Seek shelter during thunder and lightning. Plan outdoor activities with the weather in mind.

Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Manicaland, Masvingo, and the southern parts of the Midlands provinces, Clear skies and cool conditions in the morning, becoming mostly sunny and warm in the afternoon. Mild conditions towards the evening.

Actions to Take:

Ensure young children, the elderly, and those of an ill disposition are kept warm, ESPECIALLY EARLY MORNING
