SUMMARY OF THE PAST DEKAD 21-05-2025 TO 31-05-2025

Mostly clear skies and cold morning conditions dominated across the country for the dekad under review. Overnight clear skies led to low early morning temperatures, causing slight to moderate ground frost in Gweru and Matopos. Afternoons were warm across all regions. A southerly and south-easterly airflow dominated much of the country for most of the dekad. Conditions remained favourable for vegetation growth in most regions.

WEATHER OUTLOOK: JUNE 2025



Fig 1: Minimum temperature forecast for June

As shown in Fig. 1 above, minimum temperatures for the month of June are expected to be very low, ranging from 0 to 5 degrees Celsius in areas along the Highveld.

Ground frost is probable in these regions. Most parts of the country are expected to have minimum temperatures below 15°C. Mild conditions are anticipated in areas along the Zambezi Valley and the extreme districts of Matabeleland South and Masvingo provinces.

AGROMET ADVISORY

- Clear skies cause frost that harms winter wheat and vegetables—cover seedlings with mulch and irrigate fields at dawn to reduce damage.
- Freezing nights increase animal stress—provide windbreaks, extra feed, and warm drinking water for young livestock
- Frost-prone areas (Gweru/Matopos) will face more cold mornings—prioritize frost-resistant crop varieties and monitor temperatures at sunrise.
- Persistent dry, cold weather may delay spring planting—store seeds properly and prepare irrigation for early-season droughts
- Dry winds and cold days reduce soil moisture—retain crop residues and limit tillage to conserve water for winter crops
