
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING. **SATURDAY 28 JUNE 2025**



Cool, moist air from the southeast brought cloudy and cold morning conditions to Matabeleland South, southern parts of Midlands, Masvingo, and Manicaland Provinces with Masvingo district recording slight drizzle. Notably, West Nicholson recorded an unusual co-occurrence of ground frost and slight drizzle. Elsewhere, clear and cold conditions prevailed, with Hwange and **Henderson**, reporting slight ground frost.

By afternoon, temperatures in cloud-affected areas rose to mild levels, while the rest of the country enjoyed warm conditions with clouds developing in the northeastern regions.

Ensure adequate warmth during the chilly morning and nighttime hours.



Ensure adequate warmth during the chilly morning and nighttime hours




