SUMMARY OF THE PAST DEKAD 01-07-2025 TO 10-07-2025

The weather was mostly sunny across all regions during the reviewed period. Cold mornings resulted in light to moderate ground frost in places like Matopos, Buhera, Henderson, and Gweru, while afternoons were warm in most areas. A south-easterly wind flow prevailed over most regions, driven by a high-pressure system near the south-eastern coast of the subcontinent. Nationwide, evaporation rates remained under 40mm.

WEATHER OUTLOOK: JULY 2025




Fig 1: Minimum temperature forecast for July

As shown in Fig. 1 above, minimum temperatures for the month of July are expected to be very low, ranging from 0 to 5 degrees Celsius in areas along the Highveld. Ground frost is probable in these regions. Most parts of the country are expected to have minimum temperatures below 15°C. Mild conditions are anticipated in areas along the Zambezi Valley and the extreme districts of Matabeleland South and Masvingo provinces.

AGROMET ADVISORY

- Crop Protection: Mulching of sensitive crops such as tomatoes, especially in frost-prone areas. Light irrigation at dawn can help reduce frost damage.
- Livestock Care: Provide windbreaks and warm drinking water for livestock, particularly young or vulnerable animals, during cold mornings and evenings.

- Frost-Prone Areas (Kezi, Matopos): Monitor temperatures closely and prioritize frost-resistant crop varieties where possible.
- Soil & Moisture Management: Retain crop residues and minimize tillage to conserve soil moisture during dry, cold conditions.
