Overnight clear skies and calm winds led to very cold conditions this morning, with slight to severe ground frost occurring in Marondera (-4°C), Chibero (1°C), Makoholi (1°C), Gwanda (1°C), Masvingo (2°C), Mhondoro (2°C), and Henderson (2°C). As the day progressed, it became mostly sunny and warm in all areas before becoming cold again towards evening.






Actions to Take:

- If a brazier or fire is to be used indoors for warmth, ensure the room is well ventilated.
- Mitigate against frost.
- Ensure young children, the elderly and persons of an ill disposition are kept warm especially early morning and late evening.
