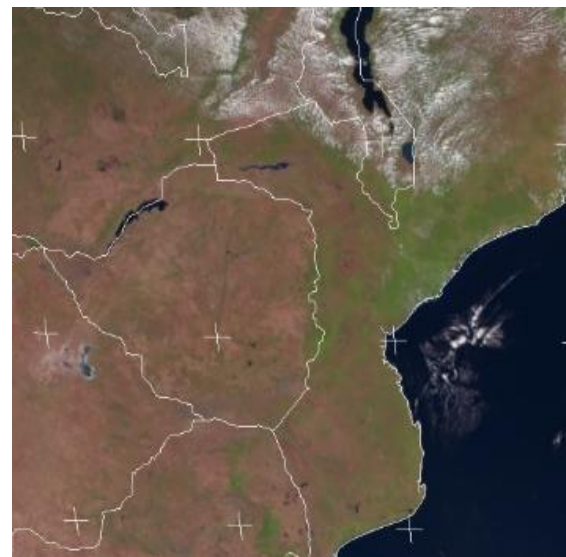




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, SUNDAY 06 JULY 2025



The day began with clear skies and cold conditions across much of the region, resulting in slight ground frost in areas such as Matopos, Nyanga, Henderson, and Mukandi. Afternoon temperatures rose, bringing warm conditions despite some patchy cloud development in the northeastern areas. By evening, temperatures declined once more, returning all areas to chilly conditions.

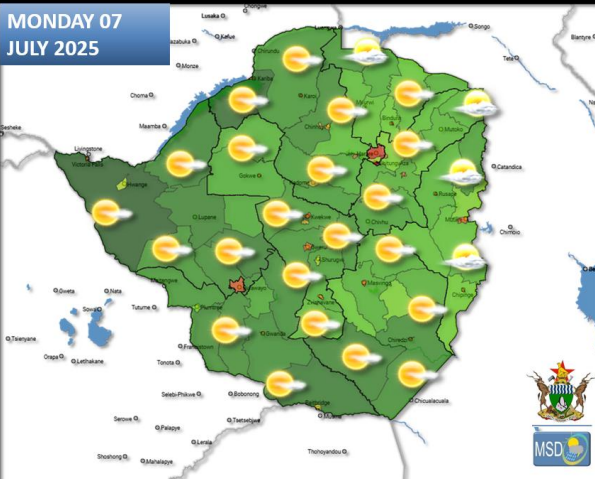
Meanwhile, a high-pressure cell situated off the southeast coast is expected to introduce a cold, moist southeasterly airflow into the southeastern parts of the country.

Clear and cold in the morning with a chance of slight to moderate ground frost in Marondera, Henderson, Rusape, and Nyanga. Partly cloudy with warm conditions by day and cold overnight.

- Ensure young children, the elderly and persons of an ill disposition are kept warm especially early morning and late evening.
- If a brazier or fire is to be used indoors for warmth, ensure the room is well ventilated.

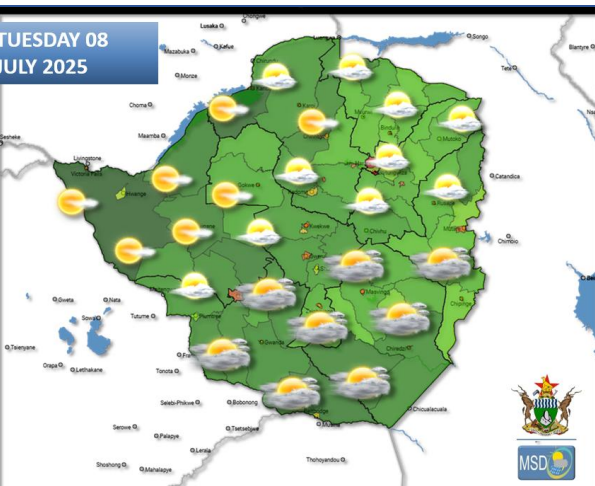
All Matabeleland, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, and Masvingo

Sunny and warm for much of the day; cold in the morning with slight ground frost in areas such as Gweru, Matopos, Gwanda and Kezi.

Actions to Take:

- Be warm early morning and late evening.
- Mitigate against frost.

Clear and cold in the morning with a chance of slight to moderate ground frost in Marondera, Henderson, Rusape and Nyanga.

Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo and South of Manicaland provinces.

Cloudy, windy and cold with patchy morning drizzle, cool by afternoon, becoming less cloudy and cold towards evening.

- Mitigate against frost.

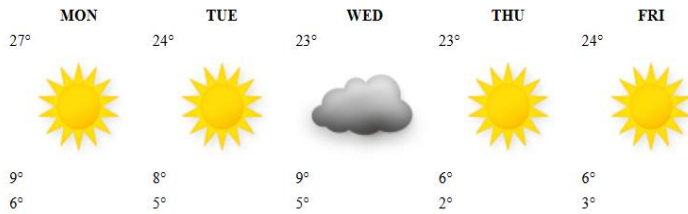
