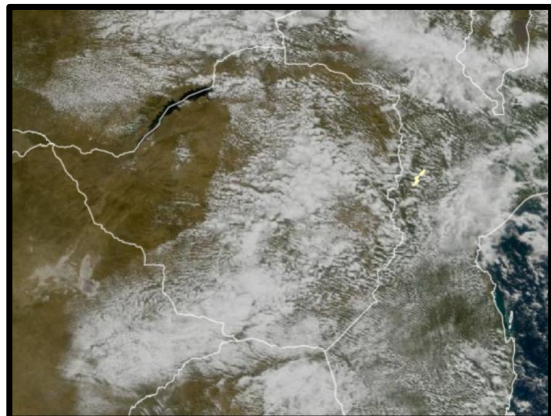




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, SUNDAY 20 JULY 2025



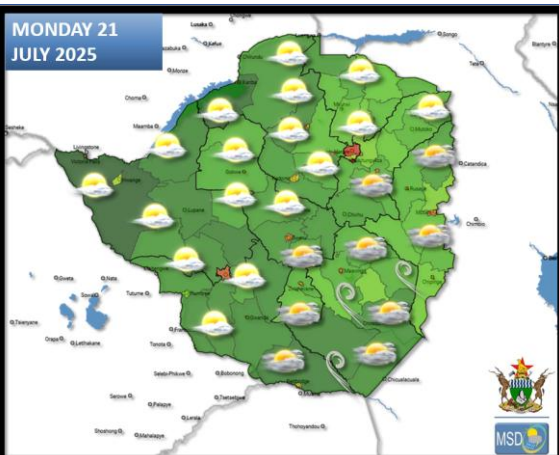
The continual advection of moist and cold south-easterly winds into the country resulted in cloudy, windy, and cold conditions over much of the country, with drizzle and light rain occurring in Manicaland, Masvingo, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, and Mashonaland Central provinces. However, much of Matabeleland North Province had mostly clear skies in the morning. As the day progressed, the whole country experienced mostly cloudy and cool conditions.

Briefly cloudy and cold in the morning, with a chance of drizzle and light rain in some areas. Conditions becoming less cloudy and cool as the day progresses.

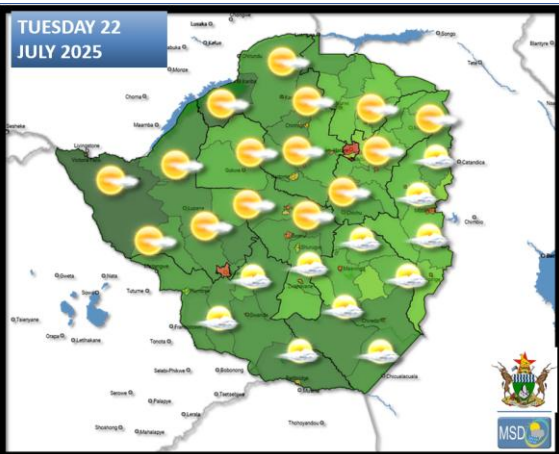
Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Harare Metropolitan, northern Midlands, Mashonaland West and Central Provinces.

Actions to Take:

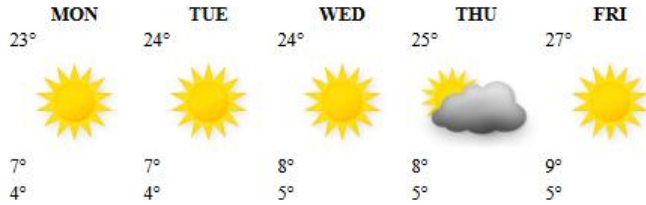
