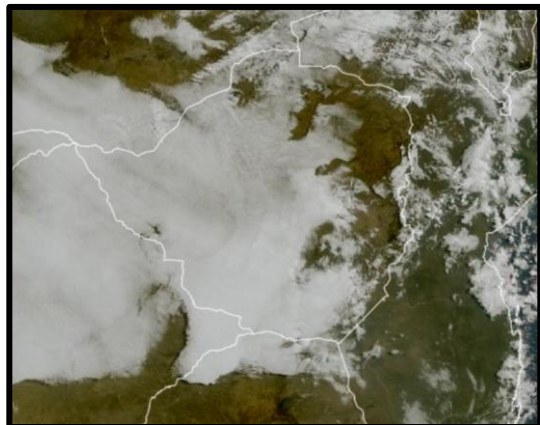




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, MONDAY 21 JULY 2025



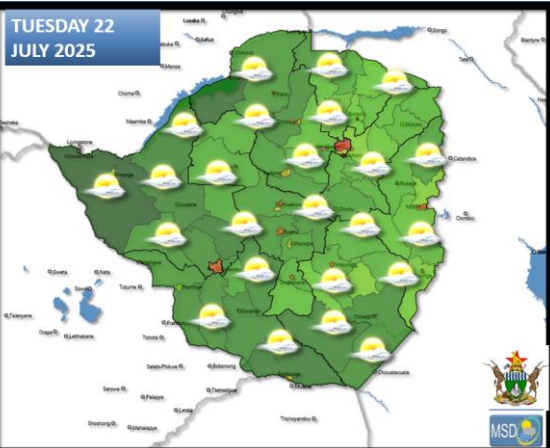

WEATHER FOR TOMORROW: TUESDAY 22 JULY 2025



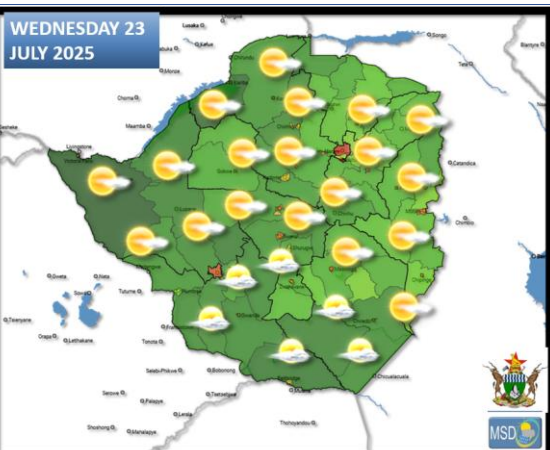
All areas
