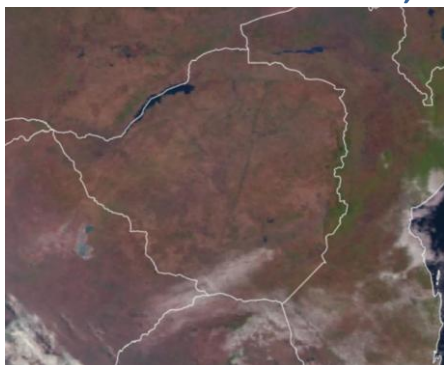




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SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, WEDNESDAY 27 AUGUST 2025,



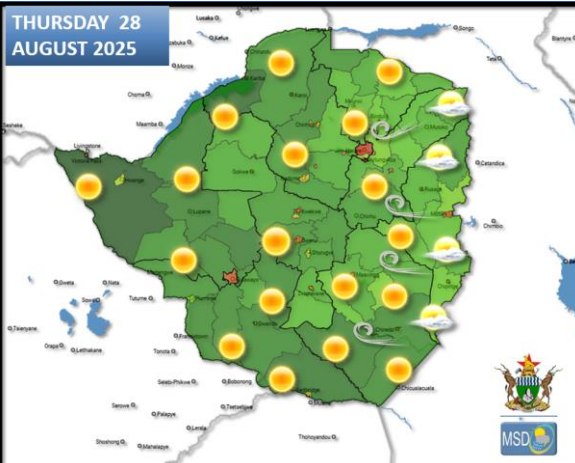
Cool and moist winds from the south east led to brief cloudy periods in districts such as Beitbridge and Chiredzi in the morning. This also reduced the occurrence of frost in most parts of the country, except **Henderson**, which recorded slight ground frost of **2°C**. By afternoon it was sunny, windy and hot across the entire country.

HOW TO PREVENT VELD FIRES



- Don't light fires in the open if you cannot control them.
- Don't leave fire unattended
- Keep an eye on the weather
- Fires in the open should not be lit in hot or windy days

Countrywide

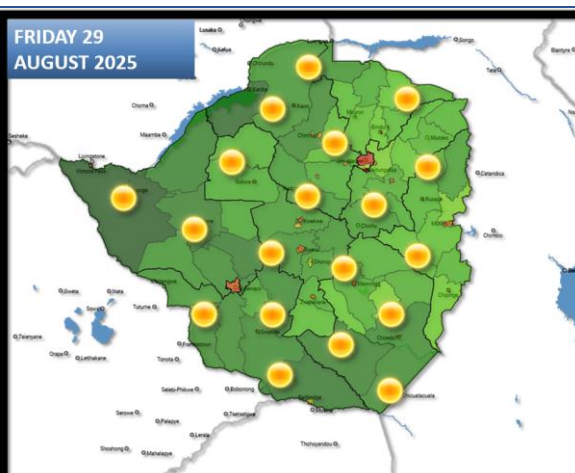
Expect windy and mostly clear skies. Cool in the morning and evening with hot daytime conditions.

Actions to Take:



- Avoid starting any outdoor fires as these may quickly spread due to the windy conditions.
- Construct fireguards that are at least 9 meters wide and free from debris or vegetative matter.
- Limit prolonged sun exposure and avoid strenuous outdoor activity during peak daylight hours.

Clear skies and windy conditions to be expected, though cold both morning and evening.

Actions to Take:



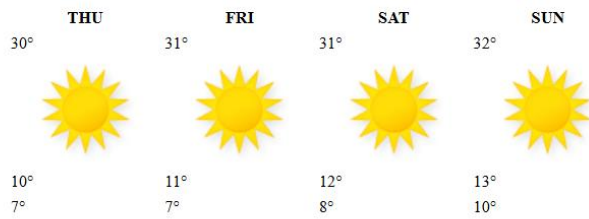
- Limit prolonged sun exposure and avoid strenuous outdoor activity during peak daylight hours.

- Allergens increase in the atmosphere due to windy conditions, please take the necessary precautions with advice from a certified health practitioner.



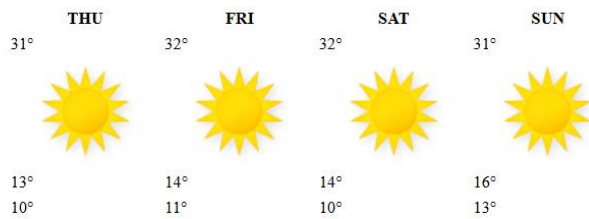
