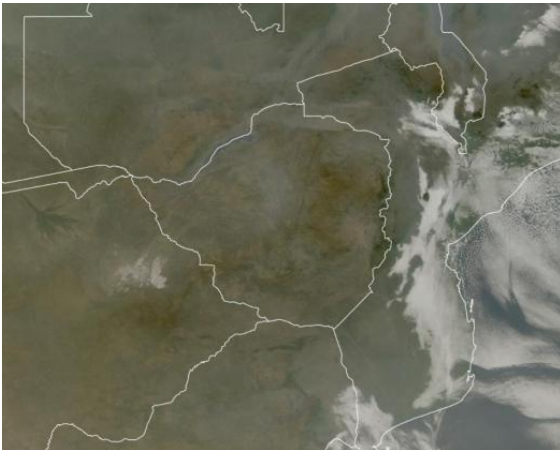




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO THIS MORNING, MONDAY 01 SEPTEMBER 2025,



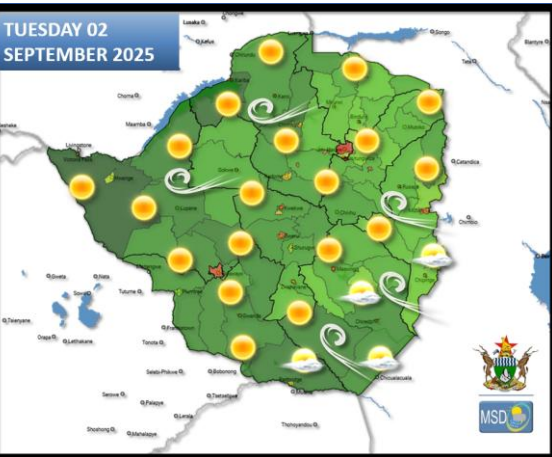
Sunny and hot conditions prevailed across much of the country, though the morning began cold and clear in the Highveld region with hazy conditions in all other areas. Meanwhile, winds are strengthening over the south-east coast of South Africa potentially affecting weather patterns tomorrow.

HOW TO PREVENT VELD FIRES

- Don't light fires in the open if you cannot control them.
- Don't leave fire unattended
- Keep an eye on the weather
- Fires in the open should not be lit in hot or windy days

Masvingo, Manicaland and Matabeleland South Provinces

Windy and cool at first with brief cloudy periods in districts such as **Chiredzi, Beitbridge and Chipinge**. Sunny and warm by afternoon in all these provinces.

Bulawayo and Harare Metropolitan, Midlands, Matabeleland North and all Mashonaland Provinces

Clear skies and cool in the morning, warm by afternoon with windy conditions, and cool towards evening.

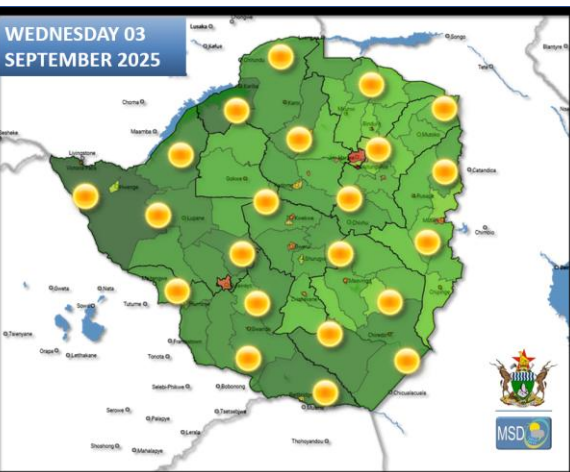

Fire danger ratings | Secure NT

- Avoid starting any outdoor fires as these may quickly spread due to the windy conditions.
- Construct fireguards that are at least 9 meters wide and free from debris or vegetative matter.
- Limit prolonged sun exposure and avoid strenuous outdoor activity during peak daylight hours.

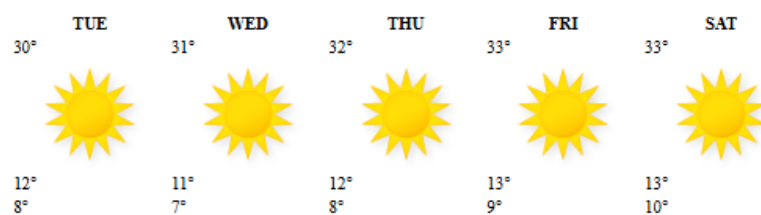
- Limit prolonged sun exposure and avoid strenuous outdoor activity during peak daylight hours.

- Allergens increase in the atmosphere due to windy conditions, please take the necessary precautions with advice from a certified health practitioner.



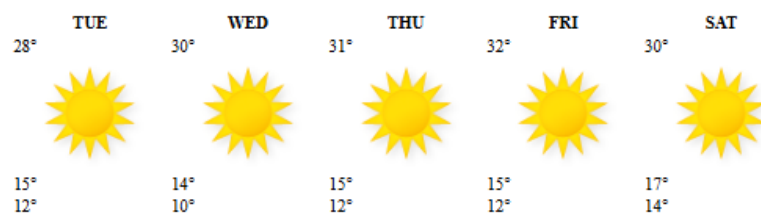
