SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, THURSDAY 09 OCTOBER 2025.



Cloud development, yesterday afternoon, in areas along and north of the main watershed led to isolated thundershowers, with the highest rainfall being only 13 mm (Nyanga). By this morning, these clouds had dissipated. However, convective activity redeveloped in the afternoon, resulting in light showers in some areas. Scattered clouds were also observed over the southern parts of the country as a cool, moist south-easterly airflow was advected inland from the east coast of southern Africa

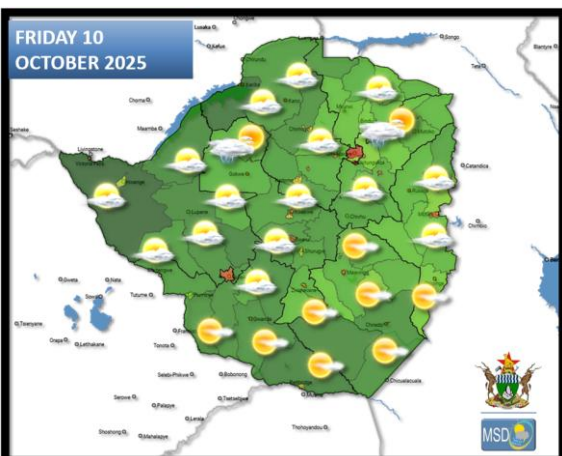

- Can strike several kms from a thunderstorm.
- If caught outside, seek inside shelter immediately. This may include vehicles.
- Do not seek shelter under tall objects such as trees or poles.
- Wait at least 30 minutes to resume activities after last bolt of lightning or thunder.

Matabeleland North, northern parts of the Midlands, Harare and Bulawayo Metropolitan, Manicaland and all Mashonaland Provinces

Mostly clear skies and mild in the morning, becoming cloudy, humid and hot in the afternoon with isolated light showers which may be thundery in places. Mild in the evening.

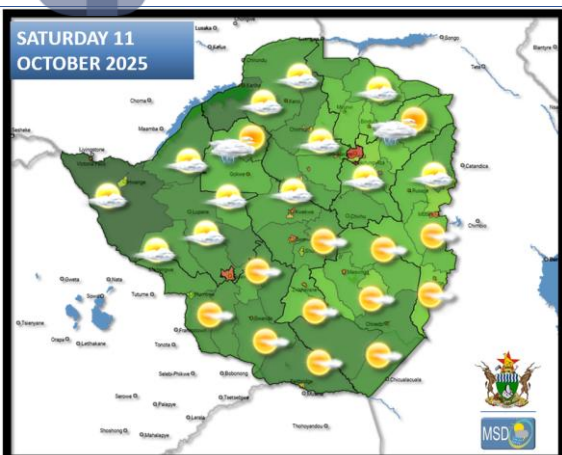
Actions to Take:

- When lightning flashes, even if the sky above you is clear, please go inside a building.
- Avoid standing under a tree or in an open space/field as lightning strikes the tallest object

All other Areas:

Cool at first, becoming mostly sunny, hazy, and hot by noon. Mild conditions in the evening.

Harare Metropolitan, all Mashonaland Provinces, Matabeleland North, north areas of Midlands and Manicaland Provinces

Cool in the morning, becoming hot in the afternoon with briefly cloudy periods and isolated light showers.

Actions to Take:

- Keep hydrated by drinking adequate amounts of water.

Southern parts of Manicaland, Masvingo, Matabeleland South, southern areas of Midlands, Bulawayo Metropolitan:

Clear skies, cool and hazy conditions in the morning. Mostly sunny and hot in the afternoon becoming cool overnight.

Actions to Take:

- Keep hydrated by drinking adequate amounts of water.
- Wear a sunhat if you need to be outdoors on in the field doing land preparations for the summer cropping season.
