

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, **SATURDAY 11 OCTOBER 2025.**



- Stay hydrated, drink plenty of water to avoid dehydration



Actions to Take:

- Ensure pregnant mothers, infants and the elderly have adequate water to drink and wear sunhats if they need to be outdoors for a prolonged period.

Limit outdoor activities during peak heat hours. Stay hydrated: Drink plenty of water to avoid dehydration














MAJOR CITIES FORECAST: SUN 12 - WED 15 OCTOBER 2025
