


SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, **MONDAY 13 OCTOBER 2025.**




Isolated thunder showers occurred yesterday in Tsholotsho, Plumtree, Matopos, Gwanda, Kezi and Victoria Falls. Today, partly cloudy and hot conditions prevailed over the northern half of the country with afternoon isolated thundershowers in parts of Matabeleland North and Bulawayo Metropolitan provinces. The remaining areas experienced sunny and hot conditions for much of the day.

Bulawayo Metropolitan, parts of Midlands, all Mashonaland, Harare Metropolitan and northern parts of Manicaland province:

Actions to Take:

Partly cloudy and hot with a chance of afternoon Matabeleland North, northern isolated thundershowers. Mild in the morning and evening.

- When lightning flashes, even if the sky above you is clear, please go inside a building.
- Avoid standing under a tree or in an open space/field as lightning strikes the tallest object.


Matabeleland South, southern Clear and mild in the morning, becoming mostly parts of Midlands, Masvingo, sunny, hazy and hot in the afternoon. Cool southern parts of Manicaland overnight. province.

Actions to Take:

Keep hydrated by drinking adequate amounts of water.

- Stay hydrated: Drink plenty of water to avoid dehydration






