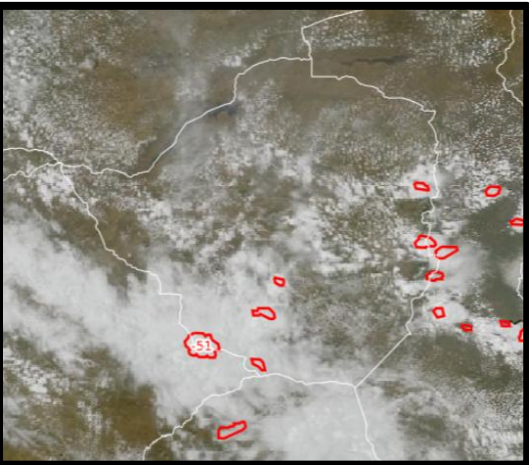


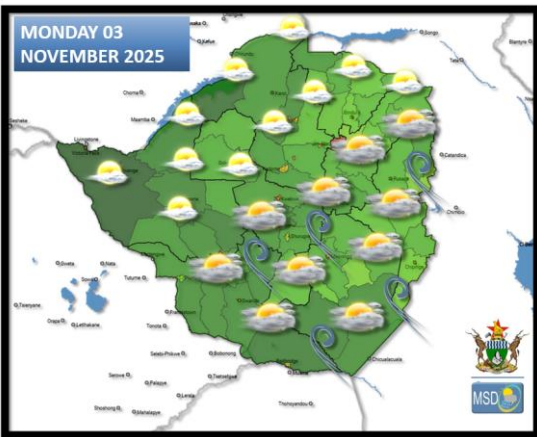
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SUNDAY 02 NOVEMBER 2025.



Isolated thundershowers were experienced over much of **Matabeleland provinces** due to an influx of moisture from Botswana. This morning, partly cloudy and cool conditions prevailed in all areas in the morning except for areas in **Matabeleland South** which were under cloudy conditions. As the day progressed, the warm conditions and the presence of moisture led to isolated afternoon thundershowers in parts of **Masvingo, Manicaland and Matabeleland South provinces**. Meanwhile, pressure is rising along the south-east coast of South Africa.

Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, parts of Midlands and Manicaland Provinces.

Mostly cloudy, windy, and cool conditions with a chance of light rain and drizzle in the morning, becoming warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated showers. Cool conditions overnight.

- Light rain can make sidewalks and roads slippery. Walk carefully to avoid slipping.
- When thunder roars, even if distant, seek shelter and stay inside for at least 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder.

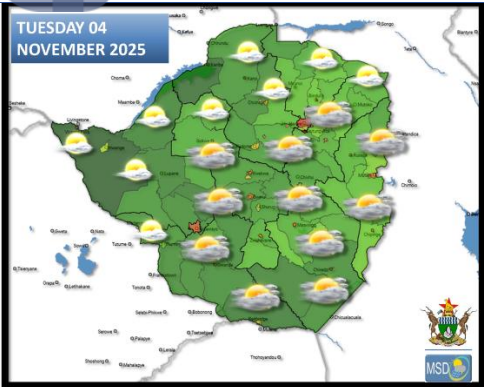
Matabeleland North, Harare Metropolitan and all Mashonaland provinces.

Actions to Take:

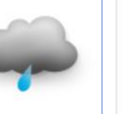
