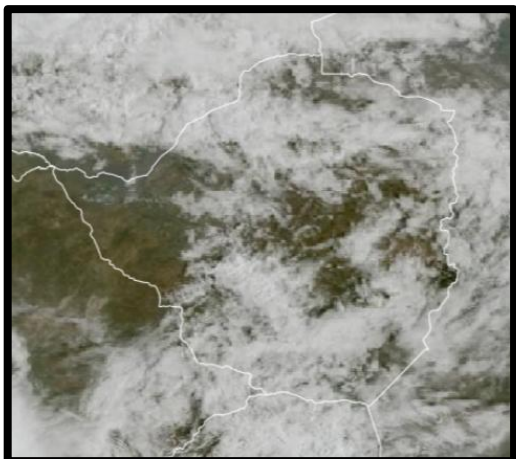




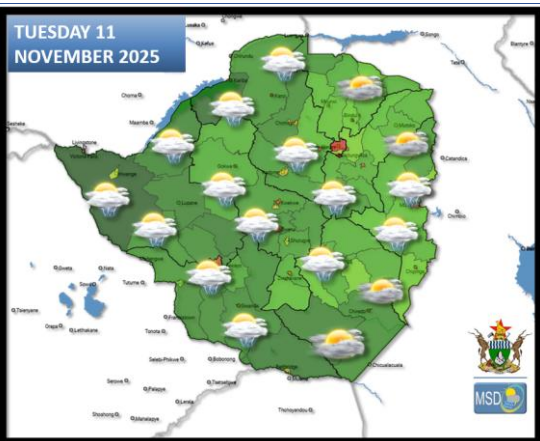
SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 10 NOVEMBER 2025.



Atmospheric moisture over much of the highveld led to moderate rain, and the rest of the country experienced light rain yesterday. The highest rainfall amounts were measured in **Karoi(11mm), Wedza(10mm), and Kadoma(7mm)**. As the moisture content decreased today, brief cloudy and mild conditions prevailed countrywide early in the morning. However, as the day progressed mostly cloudy and warm conditions were experienced in all areas with light rain in places.

Harare Metropolitan, Mashonaland Central, Mashonaland West, Midlands, Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, northern parts of Manicaland provinces.

Briefly cloudy and cool in the morning, becoming partly cloudy and warm in the afternoon. Isolated thundershowers are probable in places.

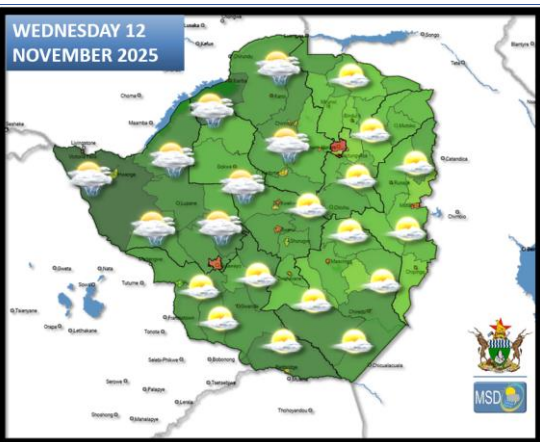
Mashonaland East, Masvingo and southern parts of Manicaland provinces.

Mostly cloudy and mild in the morning becoming warm in the afternoon with a chance of light rain or showers.

Partly cloudy and warm for much of the day though mild both in the morning and in the evening.
