
Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY. **SATURDAY 15 NOVEMBER 2025.**



A moist and unstable air mass over the country resulted in scattered thunderstorms. Notable falls were recorded in Matabeleland North, where Binga received 25.3 mm, Victoria Falls 23.7 mm, and Tsholotsho 10.5 mm. The rest of the recorded amounts were below 10 mm.

This morning, a mid-level cloud band from Botswana affected the southwestern areas, resulting in cloudy conditions and scattered thunderstorms in those areas. The rest of the country will be under cloudy and warm conditions with isolated thundershowers.

Meanwhile, a ridge of high pressure along the southeast coast will bring cool and south-easterlies into the moist southeastern areas, thereby enhancing thunderstorm activity over Zimbabwe.

All Areas:


Mostly cloudy and mild in the morning. Cloudy, windy and warm in the afternoon with scattered thunderstorms. Localized heavy downpours are likely over Masvingo, south of Midlands and Manicaland.




