
Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, **MONDAY 17 NOVEMBER 2025.**




Yesterday, widespread thunderstorms occurred across the country, with heavy rainfall totals in areas such as Buffalo Kezi Range (112mm), (106mm), Chisumbanje (87mm), Manama Mberengwa (75mm), Monyoroka Triangle (64mm), Mabee Chipinge Garahwa (60mm) and Maranda Agritex (60mm). The rest of the areas received less than 60mm.

Today, cloudy and mild conditions prevailed for much of the day with scattered thunderstorms across much of the country.

Actions to Take:


Mostly cloudy and mild in the morning. Becoming Mashonaland, northern parts of cloudy and warm in the afternoon with scattered thunderstorms. Localized heavy downpours are probable in places.

Cloudy and mild, with a chance of rain and drizzle.

- Rain can make sidewalks and roads slippery. Walk and drive carefully to avoid slipping.
- When thunder roars, even if distant, seek shelter and stay inside for at least 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder.

Partly cloudy and mild in the morning, becoming cloudy and warm in the afternoon with scattered afternoon thunderstorms and localized heavy Masvingo, Matabeleland North downpours especially over the northern areas.

Manicaland Province

Cloudy and mild in the morning with a chance of rain and drizzle. Becoming less cloudy and warm in the afternoon.

- When thunder roars, even if distant, seek shelter and stay inside for at least 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder.












MAJOR CITIES FORECAST: TUES 18 – SAT 22 NOVEMBER 2025
