



#### SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY. **TUESDAY 25 NOVEMBER 2025.**



Widespread thunderstorms were experienced yesterday over much of the country. Significant rainfall amounts were recorded in Buffalo Range (62 mm), Grand Reef (42 mm), Mutoko (32 mm) Beitbridge (27 mm), Lupane (23mm) and Mukandi (21mm) while other areas less than 20 mm precipitation. This morning, the presence of moisture resulted in mostly cloudy conditions and as the temperatures increased towards the afternoon, isolated thundershowers were experienced.

Mashonaland west, Metropolitan, Matabeleland South, Midlands, and Masvingo provinces:


Actions to Take:


