



SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 28 NOVEMBER 2025.



The presence of moisture in the atmosphere to scattered across the country thunderstorms yesterday, with significant rainfall recorded at Wedza (50 mm), Masvingo (22 mm), and Kezi (15 mm), while other areas received less than 15 mm of precipitation. Today, mostly cloudy and warm conditions prevailed nationwide for much of the day, accompanied by isolated thunderstorms in some areas.



FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: SATURDAY 29 NOVEMBER 2025




ΔII Δreas:

- When thunder roars, even if distant, seek shelter and stay inside for at least 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder.












MAJOR CITIES FORECAST: SAT 29 NOVEMBER – WED 03 DECEMBER 2025
