




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, TUESDAY 09 DECEMBER 2025.




Widespread thunderstorms affected much of the country yesterday, producing significant rainfall. The highest totals were **53 mm at Harare-Kutsaga, 33 mm at Nyanga, 31 mm at Karoi, 30 mm at Lupane, Matopos, and Mhondoro, and 27 mm at Marondera.** All other areas recorded less than 25 mm.

Today, cloudy and warm conditions prevailed across most areas of the country, with scattered thunderstorms developing in the afternoon and evening. The southern parts began with mostly clear, mild skies before becoming partly cloudy and warm with isolated thunderstorms.

Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Manicaland, and all Mashonaland provinces:

Partly cloudy and mild at first, becoming cloudy and warm in the afternoon, with scattered thunderstorms.


All Matabeleland, Masvingo, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands and southern parts of Manicaland:

Partly cloudy and mild at first, becoming warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated thundershowers.
