




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 10 DECEMBER 2025.



Much of the country experienced thunderstorms yesterday, with the highest rainfall totals recorded in **Rushinga (50mm)**, **Murewa (47 mm)**, **Rusape (39 mm)**, and **Nyazura (33 mm)**, while all other areas received less than **30 mm**. Today began with mostly cloudy and mild conditions over northern areas, while the south started off with mostly clear and mild before conditions became mostly cloudy and warm across much of the country later in the day, with isolated thunderstorms developing in some areas. Meanwhile, there is a pressure rise over the southeast coast of South Africa.

Matabeleland South, Masvingo, Harare Metropolitan and all Mashonaland provinces:

Mostly cloudy and warm conditions for much of the day, with scattered thunderstorms in places.


Matabeleland North, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands and Manicaland provinces:

Partly cloudy and mild in the morning, becoming warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated thundershowers.
