





SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, THURSDAY 11 DECEMBER 2025.




The presence of moisture in the atmosphere, combined with high temperatures over much of the country, led to scattered thundershowers yesterday, with some areas experiencing hail. The highest rainfall amounts were recorded in **Mvuma (25 mm), Mutoko (20 mm), Mufakose (20 mm), Mukandi (17 mm), Binga (16 mm), Nyamaropa (14 mm), Guruve (13 mm), and Harare Belvedere (11 mm).**

This morning, a slight pressure rise over the southeast coast of South Africa resulted in cloudy conditions over the southern parts of the country, while mostly clear skies prevailed in areas along and to the north of the main watershed. As the day progressed, partly cloudy and warm conditions dominated much of the country with isolated thundershowers in areas along the Zambezi Valley.

Partly cloudy and mild in the morning becoming warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery in places.


