





## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SUNDAY 14 DECEMBER 2025.



The abundance of moisture over the western parts of the country fueled scattered thunderstorms yesterday, resulting in heavy rainfall amounts in **Victoria Falls (82 mm)**. Notable rainfall amounts were recorded in **Murerwa (38 mm)**, **Sanyati (31 mm)**, and **Gokwe (26 mm)**. The rest of the country received less than **25 mm** of rainfall during the 24-hour period. Today, mostly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed over the western regions, while the eastern regions experienced predominantly partly cloudy and warm conditions. As the day progressed, isolated thundershowers occurred in some areas. Meanwhile, there is a rise in pressure over the southeast coast of South Africa.

**Matabeleland North, Matabeleland south, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Masvingo, Manicaland and all Mashonaland provinces.**

Partly cloudy and mild in the morning. Mostly cloudy, windy and warm in the afternoon with scattered thunderstorms. Localized heavy rainfall is possible in places.


**Harare Metropolitan and Midlands provinces.**

Mostly sunny and mild conditions in the morning becoming partly cloudy and warm in the afternoon. Isolated thunderstorms are probable towards the end of the day and during the evening.
