




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 22 DECEMBER 2025.




Yesterday, the rise in temperatures, combined with the high moisture content over the country, resulted in widespread thunderstorms and heavy rainfall in Mashonaland West, Matabeleland South, and the northern parts of Manicaland Province. Significant rainfall amounts were recorded in Kanyemba (89 mm), Mukandi (85 mm), Kezi (54 mm), Esigodini (53 mm), and Karoi (50 mm). Notable amounts were also received in Plumtree (43 mm), Harare Golf Club (40 mm), and Gweru (30 mm), while the rest of the country received less than 30 mm of precipitation.

This morning, mostly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed countrywide, with light to moderate rain in places. Brief cloud breaks during the day and warm afternoon conditions led to scattered thunderstorms towards the end of the day

Matabeleland South, Masvingo and southern parts of Manicaland provinces.


