




## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SUNDAY 07 DECEMBER 2025.




Scattered thundershowers occurred over the central and eastern regions yesterday. Notable rainfall totals included **25 mm (Kwekwe)**, **14 mm (Marondera)**, and **12 mm each in Nyanga and Masvingo**, while other areas received less than 10mm.

Today, cloudy and warm conditions prevailed across much of the country, with scattered afternoon and evening thunderstorms, though parts of Masvingo and Manicaland remained partly cloudy and warm throughout the day.

**Masvingo and Matabeleland South Provinces:**



Partly cloudy and mild at first becoming warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated thundershowers.

- When thunder roars, even if distant, seek shelter and stay inside for at least 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder.
- The public is advised to avoid crossing flooded rivers.
