




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, MONDAY 08 DECEMBER 2025.




There were widespread thunderstorms across much of the country yesterday, with significant rainfall totals of **58 mm (Chinhoyi)**, **24 mm (Mukandi)**, and **23 mm (Henderson)**, all other areas received less than 20 mm.

Today, cloudy and warm conditions prevailed across most regions, accompanied by scattered afternoon and evening thunderstorms; only the southern parts experienced light rain.

Harare Metropolitan, northern parts of Manicaland, Matabeleland North, northern parts of Midlands and all Mashonaland provinces:

Mostly cloudy and mild at first, becoming cloudy and warm in the afternoon, with scattered thunderstorms. Localized heavy downpours are probable in Mashonaland East and Manicaland.


Masvingo, Bulawayo Metropolitan Matabeleland South, southern parts of Midlands and southern parts of Manicaland provinces:
