




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, SATURDAY 27 DECEMBER 2025.




The remnant moisture over much of the northern and eastern parts of the country led to isolated thundershowers yesterday, with the highest rainfall amounts recorded at **Rushinga (60 mm), Agritex Chimukoko (37 mm), Agritex Kotwa (27 mm), Marirangwe (24 mm), Acturus (21 mm), Dotito (18 mm), Mount Darwin (15 mm), and Mutoko (11 mm).**

This morning, briefly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed over Masvingo, Manicaland, Mashonaland Central, and parts of Mashonaland East provinces. The north-western areas were partly cloudy, while the remainder of the country experienced mostly clear skies. As the day progressed, mostly sunny and warm conditions prevailed countrywide.

Mostly clear skies and mild conditions in the morning. Partly cloudy and warm in the afternoon with a chance of isolated showers that may be thundery in places.


Actions to Take:
