





## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, TUESDAY 30 DECEMBER 2025.



Yesterday highest rainfall amounts were recorded in areas such as Hwange (24mm), Belvedere-Harare (19mm), Karoi (15mm), Buffalo Range and Chisengu (14mm). In the morning, mostly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed over the southern half of the country with the remaining areas under partly cloudy conditions. However, by afternoon the whole country became mostly cloudy led to isolated thundershowers over Harare Metropolitan and all Mashonaland provinces as well as the northern parts of Manicaland Provinces.


**Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, southern parts of Midlands, Masvingo, and southern parts of Manicaland Provinces**
