




SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 31 DECEMBER 2025.



Yesterday, atmospheric moisture resulted in thunderstorm activity over the northern areas of the country, with **Hwange recording 21 mm and Victoria Falls 07 mm**. Showers and rain were recorded over the southern and eastern parts in areas such as **Zaka (6 mm), Nyanga (4 mm), and Chisengu (3 mm)**. This morning, mostly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed over the northern half of the country, while the remaining areas experienced mostly clear skies. However, by afternoon the entire country became partly cloudy, leading to isolated thundershowers over Matabeleland North, northern Midlands, Harare Metropolitan, all Mashonaland provinces, and the northern parts of Manicaland Province.




SEE A FLASH, DASH INSIDE!

- If caught outside, seek inside shelter immediately. This may include vehicles.
- Do not seek shelter under tall objects such as trees or poles.
- Wait at least 30 minutes to resume activities after last bolt of lightning or thunder.




