




## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 07 JANUARY 2026.



Yesterday's thunderstorms resulted in highest rainfall amounts over the eastern parts of the country, with **Mount Darwin** receiving **48 mm** and **Hauna (Mutare)** **13 mm**. All other areas received less than 10 mm.

Today, cloudy and mild morning conditions prevailed over the northeastern parts of the country, while mostly sunny skies were observed elsewhere. By afternoon, scattered thunderstorms developed over the northern half of the country, with partly cloudy and warm conditions persisting in the remaining areas.



Mostly cloudy and mild conditions in the morning, with a chance of light rain. Cloudy and warm in the afternoon, with scattered thundershowers in places.


**Midlands, Manicaland, Masvingo, Bulawayo Metropolitan and all Matabeleland provinces:**
