



SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 09 JANUARY 2026.



Isolated thundershowers occurred yesterday in the northern and eastern parts of the country. Some of the highest rainfall totals recorded were 24 mm in Chisengu, 23 mm in Guruve, 23 mm in Karoi, 15 mm in Chipinge, 13 mm in Kariba, and 11 mm in Chisumbanje. The rest of the rainfall received was below 10 mm.

Today, mostly cloudy and warm conditions prevailed across the country, with isolated afternoon thundershowers in places.



FORECAST FOR TOMORROW: SATURDAY 10 JANUARY 2026




Mashonaland central, Mashonaland East, Harare Metropolitan, Manicaland, Masvingo and parts of Matabeleland South Mostly cloudy and warm for much of the day with scattered afternoon thunderstorms. Localized downpours are probable in places.

Midlands, the remaining of Matabeleland South, Bulawayo Metropolitan, Matabeleland North and Mashonaland West provinces Partly cloudy and mild in the morning, becoming mostly cloudy and warm in the afternoon with isolated showers that could be thundery in places.

- Seek shelter in a safe building or hard topped vehicle to avoid lightning strikes.
