




## SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, WEDNESDAY 14 JANUARY 2026.



Yesterday, scattered thunderstorms occurred over much of the country. The highest recorded rainfall totals were **Buffalo Range (47 mm), Mutoko (44 mm), Zaka (44 mm), Goetz-Bulawayo (43 mm), Kanyemba (43 mm), Mukandi (41 mm), and Karoi (40 mm)**. All other areas received less than **40 mm** of rainfall.

Today, conditions were mostly cloudy and mild across the country for much of the day. As the day progressed, scattered showers and thunderstorms occurred this afternoon in some areas.

If caught outside, seek inside shelter immediately. This may include vehicles.


Do not seek shelter under tall objects such as trees or poles.

**Harare Metropolitan, Manicaland and all Mashonaland provinces:**

Mostly cloudy and mild conditions will prevail for much of the day. Scattered thunderstorms in the afternoon, with a risk of locally intense rainfall.


**Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, Masvingo and Matabeleland Provinces:**

Mostly cloudy and mild conditions are expected for much of the day. Isolated showers, which may be thundery, are likely in some places.

**Actions to Take:**

- The public is advised to avoid crossing flooded rivers to prevent loss of life.
- Seek shelter in a safe building or hard topped vehicle to avoid lightning strikes.

**Harare Metropolitan, Manicaland and all Mashonaland provinces:**

Mostly cloudy and mild conditions at first, becoming cloudy and warm in the afternoon. Scattered thunderstorms with localized heavy downpours are likely in some areas.

**Bulawayo Metropolitan, Midlands, Masvingo and Matabeleland Provinces:**

Mostly cloudy and mild conditions are anticipated for much of the day. In some areas, isolated showers that could be thundery are likely.

**Actions to Take:**



- Seek shelter in a safe building or hard topped vehicle to avoid lightning strikes.




