




Weather Report & Forecast

SATELLITE-BASED GLANCE INTO TODAY, FRIDAY 16 JANUARY 2026.



The presence of abundant moisture over much of the areas in Manicaland provinces led to scattered thunderstorms province with the notable rainfall amounts being experienced in **Rusape and Mutasa (48 mm), and Nyanga (45 mm)**. Elsewhere isolated thundershowers prevailed with highest rainfall amounts being received in **Masvingo(23mm), Mhondoro(16mm), Kwekwe(11mm), and Chivhu(6mm)**.

This morning, mostly cloudy and mild conditions prevailed countrywide but towards the afternoon warm and humid conditions developed resulting in isolated thundershowers in some areas.



Matabeleland South, Masvingo, and the southern parts of Manicaland provinces.


